Statement of Philosophy



Lindfield Activity Centre is an Out of School Hours Care Centre, that strives to cater to the needs of the Lindfield Public School community. Our aim as a not-for-profit organisation is to provide accessible and affordable quality care in a welcoming and nurturing environment. This is achieved through an inclusive child-centered program, quality staffing and the promotion of healthy lifestyle choices.

We believe that the children who attend our centre should create a program that reflects their diverse interests. We value play-based learning and the opportunity it creates for children to explore, experiment, and engage with one another in our environments. Our hope is that through our program we can acknowledge our children's ideas, whilst utilising the knowledge of our Educators to create moments of intentional and spontaneous learning.

LAC strives for the inclusion of all children who attend our service. We understand that each child has differing needs and that everyone develops in different ways. We are committed to supporting all children to access opportunities regardless of their diverse circumstances and abilities.

At LAC we recognise the importance of establishing healthy lifestyle choices with children from a young age. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What time can I drop off my child in the morning?

You can drop off your child any time between 7:15 and 8:30 in the morning. From 8:30 onwards, to school grounds are supervised, therefore they can go straight to school.

What time do I pick my child up in the afternoon?

You can pick your child up any time after 3pm and before 6pm

What do I do if my child is going to be absent from LAC?

Login to Becklyn and mark them as absent. This must be done before 12pm on the business day prior. If you miss this cut off, please call or email the centre to let us know!

Do LAC take children to their after school lessons?

Yes! You will need to download an extra curricular permission form from our website and fill it in. Then email it to the centre, and we will have an educator take your child to and from their lesson

KINDY PROGRAM

LAC has created a specialised kindy program that runs for the first term of the year to allow the incoming Kindergarten children to feel supported through the transition to school. The program occurs in the 'Kindy Room' that is designed to give the kindy children a calm and structured environment that is targeted at their developmental level allowing them to flourish at LAC. The program focuses on creating intra-year friendships, and developing social skills and cognitive development through story circles and crafts.

LAC ROUTINE

Morning Routine

7:15am - LAC OPENS

Responsible Person (RP) will mark the children's names off on arrival

7:15am - 8:15am - Breakfast Serviced

(Cereal, Toast, Fruit)

7:15am - 8:30am Free Play/Outside Games

The children have access to toys, books and games for the duration of the morning.

8:30am-8:45am - Time for School!

The RP checks the children's names off as they go up to school.

Afternoon Routine

3:00pm - LAC OPENS

The children line up outside the centre, walking in as the RP marks their name off the roll.

3:00pm-3:20pm - Afternoon Snack and Meetings

The children have the option of an afternoon snack and some fruit, whilst sitting on the mat with their year level having a meeting about the activities of the afternoon.

3:20pm-5:00pm - Activities

Educators run and supervisor a range of activities and sports guided by the 'My Time Our Place' Framework.

5:00pm - Pack Up Time and Meeting

The children clean up their activities, sit on the mat for a centre meeting and enjoy a late afternoon snack.

5:15pm - 6:00pm - Free Play/Quiet Activities

6:00pm - LAC CLOSES


FINDING US!

We are located within the school grounds of Lindfield Public School. For drop off and pick up we ask that you enter through the Grosvenor Rd staff car park footpath entrance. (Driveway opposite to 8 Grosvenor Rd).

Please do not park in the staff car park after 7:30am and before 4:30pm. Parking on Grosvenor Rd is available.

A member of staff will be at the gate to welcome your child into the centre and sign them in and out. You do not need to sign your own child in or out.
